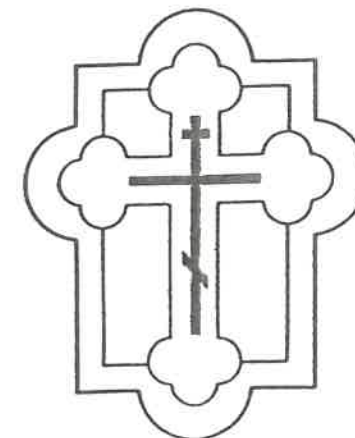

Philip's Fast / Filipovka Post': The Pre-Christmas fast is underway – 40 days of spiritual preparation before Christmas. Recognizing the significance of the Great Feast of the Incarnation of the Eternal God in the flesh, perhaps we might commit to a minimal observance of the Fast by extending Simple Abstinence from meat and meat products to Wednesdays in addition to Fridays.

Bishop Kurt has issued a dispensation for those observing the traditional (Strict Fast) form of the Pre-Christmas fast for both Thanksgiving Day and the Friday following it.
