THE DORMITION FAST will begin on August 1st (this Wednesday) and continues through August 14th. Traditionally this preparatory period before the *Great Feast of the Dormition of the Holy Mother of God* was a time of Strict Fast on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays (no meat or dairy products) and a lesser fast on Tuesdays and Thursdays (no meat) with mitigations of the fast on Saturdays, Sundays, and the Feast of the Transfiguration (August 6th). While the observance of this fast today is voluntary, we should practice Simple Abstinence (from meat) on all Fridays and extend the abstinence to Wednesdays during the fast period.
